

Peter: Down But Not Out

Matthew 17:1-8

It was a conference on comparative religions with C.S. Lewis as one of the panel participants. When asked about Christianity's unique contribution among world religion, Lewis said "Oh that's easy. It's grace."

The Apostle Peter holds a prominent place on the pages of the four Gospels and the book of Acts. Included in Scripture are two of Peter's epistles. And yet, there are a number of episodes recorded in the New Testament when Peter, well, "messed up".

We review some of his missteps this morning but highlight the manner in which God's grace offset Peter's frailties.
