They will then move down the center aisle, lighting candles of those on this end of the pews. Please tip your unlit candle into your neighbor's lit candle. Please keep the lighted candle upright. Please do your best to not tip a lighted candle as tipping will spill hot wax. (Yes, the large cups do help, but it's best to simply avoid tipping a lighted candle).

When the candles have been lit, we will stand and sing together two verses of Silent Night, Holy Night (the words are printed on page 2). The pastor will exit down the center aisle. The congregation will follow, beginning with the first row. Please take your coat and other belongings into the courtyard and join others there, Rev. Meads will conclude the service by giving the Christmas Blessing.
