

The Significance of Pentecost Sunday

1. Pentecost means “50”. Fifty days after Passover.
2. It all started in Egypt.
 - A. The beginning of the Passover.
Ex. 11:1,5; 12:3, 6-7, 11-14, 23
3. God ordained three major feast days for Israel. The Passover, the Day of Pentecost, and the Feast of Harvest.
Lev. 23:5, 16, 24, 27
4. Jesus’ crucifixion would be the fulfillment of the Passover Lamb slain.
Matt. 26:17-20; and 26:26-28
5. The outpouring of the Holy Ghost would be the fulfillment of the Feast of Pentecost. (50 days after Jesus was crucified). **Acts 1:3-5, 8**
 - A. When it happened. **Acts 2:1-4**
 - B. Who witnessed it. **Acts 2:5-12**
Jews from 16 different countries.
6. Peter’s message to these Jews. **Acts 2:14, 17, 21, 37-42**
 - A. Repentance and water baptism in the Name of Jesus Christ, “For the remission of sins.” (not forgiveness only)
 - B. The Name of Jesus is the only name that will save us.
Acts 4:12
7. Water baptism in Jesus Name confirmed. **Acts 8:16; 10:48; 19:5**
8. The last feast day, The Feast of Harvest, also called The Feast of Trumpets represents the wrap-up of the gospel being preached in all the world. Jesus will return to rapture the church and judge the world.
