- 1. God's Name given unto Moses. Ex. 3:13-15
  - A. The tetragrammaton (four letters JHVH or YHWH) unpronounceable.
  - B. The Jews used the word LORD (all capital letters) to substitute the Name of God.
- 2. The promise of a place for God's Name in Palestine.
  - Deut. 12:5, 11, 21
    - A. The phrase "the place" that God will choose for His Name is found 17 times here.
    - B. It represented total commitment to Israel.
    - C. "That Place" became Jerusalem under David's reign. I Chron. 15:1, 16:1
- When David desired to build a temple to God, God sent Nathan the prophet to tell David no. I Chron. 17:4, 10-14
   A. David's response. I Chron. 17:16-17
- 4. When Jesus came, He was the presence of God on earth. John 14:6-11 John 12:45

A. ...and the place of His name.

Matt. 1:21; Acts 4:12; Phil. 2:9-11
